The resident expressed concern that there was no interest from the police and there is very little police presence in the village.

The Chairman explained that the Parish Council were made aware of the incident at a meeting the previous evening and had agreed to write to Essex Police and Priti Patel MP on behalf of the resident.

#### **Fairways Committee**

A resident had requested clarification on the terms of reference, constitution, stakeholder membership and accountability of the Fairways Committee.

The Chairman advised the Fairways Committee has nothing to do with the Parish Council and suggested that the resident contact the Chairman or Secretary of the Fairways Committee who would be able to provide the information requested.
