2020 with a proposal being made to the Full Council at the meeting on Tuesday 15th December 2020.

It is hoped that the works to the Sluice Gate could be completed by week commencing 1st March 2021.

As this is a high expenditure item, the Woodup Pool Committee would propose to the Full Council that the unspent funds for Woodup Pool (Litter Collection £350 – Rangers £400 – Toilets £1,100 – Total £1850) is transferred to the Woodup Pool Earmarked Fund to go towards the replacement sluice gate.

Dependent on the grant application to the Locality Fund, the Committee may have to look at fundraising. It was suggested that the local businesses could be contacted to donate, and a JustGiving Page was set-up. It was agreed to delay the fundraising until the financial position was confirmed.

6. Precept 2021/22
