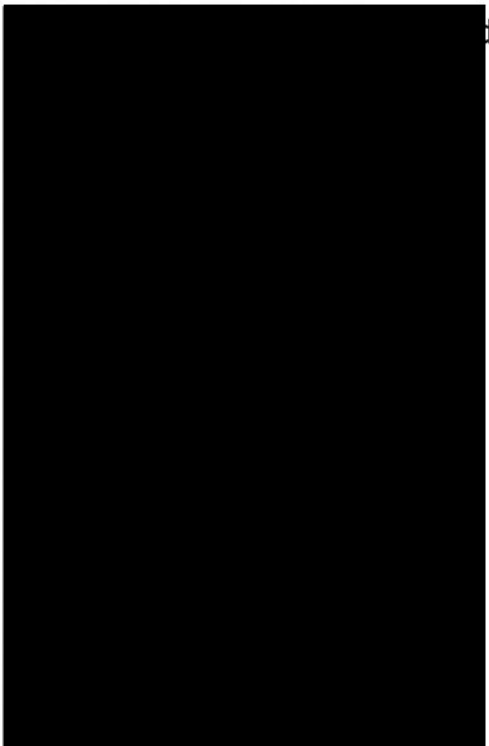

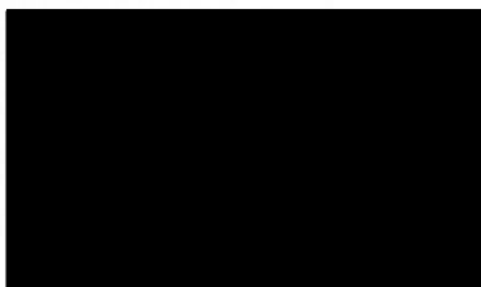
Just thought I would drop you another email regarding keeping the Saltpool open and filled with water for swimming over the winter months.

Subject: Letloos

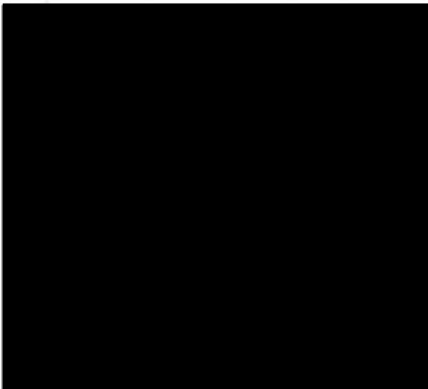
Michelle,
