Dear Councillors,

Further to your request, an assessment has been carried out by a SEPP Technician and a report sent to the SEPP Joint Committee Member and Lead Officer for parking matters in Maldon for a decision.

It was agreed by the SEPP Joint Committee Member and Lead Officer to proceed with a scheme to replace the existing single yellow lines with double yellow lines adjacent to the tidal barrier to help ensure that it can be closed at all times.

We will now outline a cost for the scheme and request funding to proceed with a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO). If funding is approved, we will publish a proposed TRO and carry out a formal consultation for 21 days. During the formal consultation members of the public can voice their support or objection to the proposal. It is essential you respond to the formal consultation if you have a view on the proposal.

The budget for new schemes has already been allocated for this financial year. Therefore, any new schemes will now be considered for the 24/25 financial year.
